Democrats for Equality Will Help Defeat Dumanis

Fmr. D.A. Dumanis's controversial record makes her unfit for office

San Diego, CA – San Diego's largest Democratic club, the San Diego Democrats for Equality, which has a 42-year record of political activism in local politics and the LGBT community, will fight to defeat former District Attorney Bonnie Dumanis in her bid for San Diego County Supervisor.

"Former District Attorney Dumanis has a controversial record that would make her a poor fit for County Supervisor." Said Will Rodriguez-Kennedy, President of the San Diego Democrats for Equality. "[From prosecuting people of color with a controversial and unconstitutional quilt-by-association legal theory, to taking illegal foreign contributions, to subverting the democratic process to anoint her hand chosen successor in a series of backroom deals, to allegedly intimidating political opponents.](#) Dumanis has turned her law enforcement career into a demonstration of cruel, backroom dealing, above-the-law politics."

"Our club has joined a broad coalition of progressive, Democratic and community leaders who have endorsed Nathan Fletcher for this seat, and we encourage all San Diegans to support him for this seat."

The San Diego Democrats for Equality were the first Democratic club to endorse in this race, and former Assemblymember Nathan Fletcher was endorsed after a decisive vote on August 17th, 2017. Subsequently, Fletcher won an endorsement recommendation from the San Diego County Democratic Party's Central Area members with 90% of the vote, a critical step in the endorsing process before consideration of the Democratic Party's full Central Committee.

San Diegans will go to the polls to decide the outcome of this race on June 5th, 2018
